

POSB PAssion Run for Kids 2016 (“Event”)

Rules & Regulations

The Event is organised by DBS/POSB and People’s Association (collectively, the “**Organisers**”).

Registration

1. All registrations are on a first-come-first-served basis and must be made via the official online registration portal. All payments are to be charged to specified credit cards. No cheques will be accepted.
2. Participants below 18 years of age must seek parental or guardian consent before registering for the Event.
3. Once the registration form has been duly processed, there shall be strictly no fee refund for whatever reason.
4. A participant with a valid promotion code is required to enter the promotion code in the online registration form in order to enjoy any discount. No refunds will be given for any promotion code that is unutilized.
5. Race categories or race entries that have been registered are non-transferrable and non-assignable by the participant.
6. Selection of T-shirt size is subject to availability. No exchanges will be allowed.

Race Pack Collection

7. All participants are required to collect their race pack which includes the Event apparel, number bib, race chip and other sponsored products (if any) (collectively the ‘**Race Pack**’) at the POSB PAssion Run for Kids 2016– Race Expo on 27th and 28th of Aug.
8. The replacement fee for a lost number bib or race chip is S\$5.00 and S\$50.00 respectively.
9. All participants are required to produce their NRIC or Passport for the collection of the Race Pack.
10. If the participants are unable to collect their Race Pack in person, they may authorize a representative (“**Authorized Representative**”) in accordance with the procedures detailed in www.posb.com.sg/runforkids. The participants confirm the following:
 - (a) warrants that he/she has obtained consent under the Act from the Authorized Representative to the collection, use and disclosure of the Authorized Representative’s personal data by/to the Organisers and/or their agents or vendors and such other third party for the purpose of the Event; and
 - (b) confirm that he/she has procured that the Authorized Representative has read and agrees to be bound by the terms of the DBS Privacy Policy.

Medical/Safety

11. It is the responsibility of the participants to have themselves medically certified fit to participate in the Event. A participant must withdraw from the race immediately if required to do so by any member of the official medical team.
12. In the event of an emergency arising from any incidents affecting the key installations in the vicinity of the Event venue, the Event will be cancelled without prior notice.

Race

13. A participant must wear the Event apparel, number bib and race chip during the Event. Failure to do so will result in the disqualification of that participant.
14. Participants who do not start within 15 minutes from the respective flag-off times will be disqualified.
15. Participants must run on the designated route. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
16. In accordance with the International Association of Athletic Federation (IAAF), the official recognized race time is based on Gun Time for all categories, unless otherwise stated. The recognized race time for kids' categories is based on Chip (Net) Time.
17. There will be no fee refunds for any participant who is disqualified for any reason.
18. Participants are advised not to leave any cash or valuables (including but not limited to mobile phones) at the baggage deposit counter. The Organisers shall not be responsible or liable in the event of any loss or damage.
19. Pets or any form of wheel-run objects of transport (including but not limited to in-line skates, prams, push chairs and shoes with rollers) are not allowed on the entire race course.
20. Any disputes over the official race results must be made on-site in person, in a written format within 15 minutes upon the release of the said results. A S\$50.00 non-refundable fee will be levied per dispute investigation request. The Organisers' decision on the dispute investigation request shall be final and binding on all affected participants.

Waiver

21. The participants fully understand and acknowledge the risks involved in their participation in the Event and accept full responsibility and assume all such risks.
22. The participants (including their heirs, successors and assigns) undertake not to make any claims, lodge any complaints whatsoever or hold liable the Organisers, sponsors or officials of the Event for any injury, death, cost, expense, claims or loss/damage to property of whatsoever nature and howsoever arising in relation to the Event.
23. The participants (including their heirs, successors and assigns) agree to hold the Organisers, Sponsors, appointed officials/suppliers (each an **'Indemnified Party'**) harmless and keep each Indemnified Party fully and effectively indemnified from and against any and all losses, costs (including legal costs on a full indemnity basis), claims, damage and expenses whatsoever which any of them may incur (directly or indirectly) as a result of their breach of any of these Rules and Regulations.

General

24. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, delay, postpone or change the venue, date and time of the Event for whatever reasons, including inclement weather or other unfavourable weather conditions (e.g. haze). There will be no fee refund if the Event is cancelled for whatever reason.
25. The participants consent to the Organizers contacting them for any matter in relation to this Event, including but not limited to receiving notification e-mails and/or SMSes in connection with this Event.
26. The participants further consent under the Personal Data Protection Act (Cap 26 of 2012) ("**Act**") to the collection, use and disclosure of the participants' personal data by/to the Organisers and/or their agents or vendors and such other third party for the purpose of the Event and the participants confirm that they have read and agree to be bound by the terms of the DBS Privacy Policy, a copy of which can be found on www.dbs.com/privacy.
27. The Organisers may amend any of these Rules and Regulations without prior notice or liability to any party. In the event of any inconsistency between these Rules and Regulations and any brochures, marketing or promotional materials relating to the Event, these Rules and Regulations shall prevail.
28. The Organisers' decision on all matters arising out of or in relation to this Event shall be final and binding on the participants. DBS/POSB shall not be obliged to enter into any correspondence on any matter concerning the Event.
