

POSB PAssion Run for Kids 2019 (“Event”)

Rules & Regulations

The Event is organised by DBS/POSB and People’s Association (collectively, the “**Organisers**”).

Registration

1. Registration is capped at 8,000 participants and is on a first-come-first-serve basis. All registrations and payments must be made via the official online registration portal, managed by DBS Bank Ltd.
2. Participants below 18 years of age must seek parental or guardian consent before registering for the Event.
3. After a participant’s registration is confirmed, there shall be strictly no refund of registration fees.
4. A participant with a valid promotion code is required to enter the promotion code during online registration in order to enjoy any applicable discount. No refunds will be given for any unutilized promotion code.
5. Race categories or race entries registered are non-transferrable and non-assignable by the participant.
6. Change of T-shirt sizing is not allowed after confirmation of registration.

Race Pack Collection

7. All participants are required to collect their race pack (“**Race Pack**”) which includes the Event apparel, bag, race bib, race chip and other sponsored items (if any) at the POSB PAssion Run for Kids 2019 Race Expo (details to be advised when available on the official Event page). Race Pack collection is managed by Esprimo Pte. Ltd (“**Esprimo**”).
8. The replacement fee for a misplaced race bib or race chip is S\$5.00 and S\$50.00 respectively.
9. All participants are required to produce their NRIC or Passport or email confirmation slip for the collection of the Race Pack.
10. If the participants are unable to collect their Race Pack in person, they may authorise a representative (“**Authorised Representative**”) in accordance with the procedures detailed on www.posb.com.sg/runforkids. In providing the Authorised Representative’s information to the Organisers via Esprimo, each participant confirms:
 - (a) that he/she has obtained consent from the Authorised Representative for Esprimo’s collection, use and disclosure of the Authorised Representative’s personal data by/to the Organisers and/or their agents or vendors and such other third party for the purposes of the Event.
 - (b) that he/she has procured that the Authorised Representative has read and agreed to be bound by the terms of the DBS Privacy Policy.

Medical/Safety

11. It is the responsibility of the participants to have themselves medically certified fit to participate in the Event. A participant must withdraw from the race immediately if required to do so by any member of the official medical team.
12. In the event of an emergency arising from any incidents affecting the key installations in the vicinity of the Event venue, the Event will be cancelled without prior notice.

Race

13. Participants may be disqualified if they do not:

- (a) wear the Event apparel, race bib and race chip during the Event;
- (b) start [the race] within 15 minutes from the respective flag-off times; or
- (c) run on the designated route.

There will be no fee refunds for any participant who is disqualified for any reason.

14. In accordance with the International Association of Athletic Federation (IAAF), the official recognised race time is based on Gun Time for all categories, unless otherwise stated. The recognised race time for the Kids' categories is based on Chip (Net) Time.
15. Participants are advised not to leave any cash or valuables (including but not limited to mobile phones) at the baggage deposit counter. The Organisers shall not be responsible or liable in the event of any loss or damage.
16. Pets or any form of wheel-run transport (including but not limited to in-line skates, prams, push chairs and shoes with rollers) are not allowed on the entire race course.
17. Any dispute over the official race results must be made on-site in person, in a written format within 15 minutes upon the release of the said results. Thereafter, a S\$50.00 non-refundable fee will be levied per dispute investigation request. The Organisers' decision on the dispute investigation request shall be final and binding on all affected participants.

Waiver of Liability

18. The participants fully understand, acknowledge and assume the risks involved in participating in the Event and accept full responsibility for such risks.
19. The participants (including their heirs, successors and assigns) undertake not to make any claims, lodge any complaints whatsoever or hold liable the Organisers, sponsors or officials of the Event for any injury, death, cost, expense, claims or loss/damage to property of whatsoever nature and howsoever arising in relation to the Event.
20. The participants (including their heirs, successors and assigns) agree to hold the Organisers, Sponsors, appointed officials/suppliers (each an **'Indemnified Party'**) harmless and keep each Indemnified Party fully and effectively indemnified from and against any and all losses, costs (including legal costs on a full indemnity basis), claims, damage and expenses whatsoever which any of them may incur (directly or indirectly) as a result of their breach of any of these Rules and Regulations.

General

21. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, delay, postpone or change the venue, date and time of the Event for whatever reasons, including inclement weather or other unfavourable weather conditions (e.g. haze). In the event of an emergency arising from any incidents affecting the key installations in the vicinity of the Event venue, the Event may be cancelled without prior notice. There will be no fee refund if the Event is cancelled for whatever reason.
22. Participants consent to the collection, use and disclosure of their personal particulars by/to the Organisers and/or their agents, vendors and such other third party for the purpose of the Event. The participant agrees to the terms of the DBS Privacy Policy, a copy which can be found at www.dbs.com/privacy. The participants agree that the Organisers may contact them for any matter in

relation to this Event, including but not limited to receiving notification e-mails and/or SMSes in connection with this Event.

23. If a third party registers on behalf of a participant for the Event (the “**Registering Party**”), the Registering Party confirms that he/she has obtained consent from the participant and consents on behalf of the participant to the Organisers’ collection, use and disclosure of the participant’s personal particulars for the purpose of the Event. The Registering Party also, on the participant’s behalf, agree to the terms of the DBS Privacy Policy.
24. The participants also accept that they may be photographed/video recorded at the Event and that some of these photographs/video recording may be utilized in the Organisers’ materials and/or featured on the Organisers’ websites or external publications. The Organisers shall not be required to make any payments to any participant for the use and/or publication of any photographs/video recording involving the participant.
25. The Organisers may amend any of these Rules and Regulations without prior notice or liability to any party.
26. The Organisers’ decision on all matters arising out of or in relation to this Event shall be final and binding on the participants. DBS/POSB shall not be obliged to enter into any correspondence on any matter concerning the Event.
