POSB PAssion Kids Fund

The POSB PAssion Kids Fund aims to support children in the community through development programmes in Singapore. To date, approximately 867,600 children have benefited from the 218 programmes supported by the Fund. Notable programmes this year include:

Nee Soon Football and Study Programme

In collaboration with Espzen Soccer School, the Nee Soon Football Study and Programme is a ground-up initiative launched in 2015 to promote healthy living and build confidence amongst primary and secondary schools students in the Nee Soon Group Representative Constituency (GRC). The programme comprises two key components – study and character building and football training, which offers students under the Ministry of Education Financial Assistance Scheme (MOE FAS) a chance to learn and grown in education and sports; as well as provides opportunities for benefitting youths to do their part for the community.

Community Scouting @ North East

Community Scouting is a programme that provides youths with an opportunity to join scouting activities beyond classrooms and schools. Through fun and wholesome activities with family members and community members, these youths experience achievements and learning as well as family bonding and community integration through their parents' direct involvement.

YEAH Programme

Youth Engage at Heartland (YEAH!) @ Tampines West aims to assist children between 9 and 12 years old to develop their life skills and build capabilities necessary for character development, civic mindedness and sustain academic success.





POSB -Jurong Spring Zone E RC Dream Savers, Dream Makers 2022

The POSB – Jurong Spring Zone E RC's Dream Savers aims to build financial literacy and inculcate good savings habits amongst underprivileged children and youths aged between 7 to 16 years old. It is hoped that the positive money attitudes acquired by the participants can percolate to the rest of their families,

hopefully having a transformative effect on the financial behaviours and cycles. Participants were rewarded with incentives after they had completed eco challenges in reducing, reusing, and recycling.

RACE DETAILS

10KM/5KM ADULTS COMPETITIVE AND 10KM TEAM CHALLENGE:

Official results are based on the Gun Time which begins upon the official flag off. This includes the distances covered before the start line (officially accepted by the international Athletics Federations).

KIDS COMPETITIVE:

Official results based on Chip Time, which is the time taken when runners run past the start to finish line.

PRE-RACE KIDS TENT (GET READY FOR YOUR RACE)

Report to Pre-Race Kids Tent at least 30 mins before flag-off time.

POST-RACE KIDS TENT

Kid participants will be directed to the Post-Race Kids Tent to receive their finisher medals and water in accordance to the letter in the alphabet indicated on their Race Bibs.




KIDS RUN ADVISORY

NOTE TO PARENTS WITH KIDS PARTICIPATING IN THE 1.2KM AND 800M COMPETITIVE CATEGORIES

Parents/Guardians have to wear the allocated wrist tag in order to pick up their kid from the Kids Pick-Up Area for security purposes.

Parents/Guardians who have lost their wrist tag will need to report to the information tent with their identification documents to obtain a new wrist tag.

NOTICE

SECURITY AND BAG CHECK

As part of national safety and security guidelines, all participants are required to undergo bag check(s) and/or security check(s), all participants are advised to minimise the number of personal belongings brought into the event grounds to facilitate quick security clearance.

Do note that the following items are NOT ALLOWED:

- Bicycles, skate scooters and other PMDs
- Pets except for guide dogs
- · Remote controlled devices including drones
- · Sharp objects such as, not limited to, pocket knives and scissors
- · Pyrotechnic devices such as flares or fireworks
- · All items listed under SPF prohibited items

All prohibited items found will not be allowed inside the race venue. Items found will be recorded and reported to the relevant authorities. For items found that are under the list of SPF prohibited items, a police report will be made. All participants are advised to travel light and must have their race bib to enter the race course.

RACE BIB INSTRUCTION

Participants must wear their allocated race bib at all times during the race. Runners without the allocated race bib will not be allowed to take part in the race.

































- Display your race bib clearly on the front of your race apparel at all times during the race.
- Do not alter, modify, fold or crumple the race bib.
- Please ensure that the bib is pinned on all four corners.
- The race bib is strictly non-transferable.
 Participants found doing so will be disqualified.
- Participants without race bibs will not be allowed to participate in the race.





HOW TO WEAR YOUR SHOE TAG

FOR COMPETITIVE CATEGORIES ONLY



STEP 1

STRING your shoelace through the two holes as shown as Image 1. The white side with the timing chip must face up. Tie a double knot to secure the tag.



STEP 2

LOOP the shoe tag. Use the orange clip to fasten the tag, as shown as Image 2.



STEP 3

SECURE the tag using the sticky tap as **Image 3**. Now you are ready to run and record your time!

INCORRECT WAYS OF WEARING YOUR SHOE TAG



DO NOT tie the shoe tag at the front laces of your shoes.




DO NOT flatten the shoe tag and stuff it under your laces.

- Bayfront MRT Station (DT16/CE1) 12 mins walk from Exit E
