

POSB PAssion Run for Kids Training Clinic @ Nee Soon (“Event”)

Rules & Regulations

The Event is organised by DBS/POSB and People’s Association (collectively, the “**Organisers**”).

Waiver of Liability

1. The participants fully understand, acknowledge and assume the risks involved in participating in the Event and accept full responsibility for such risks.
2. The participants (including their heirs, successors and assigns) undertake not to make any claims, lodge any complaints whatsoever or hold liable the Organisers, sponsors or officials of the Event for any injury, death, cost, expense, claims or loss/damage to property of whatsoever nature and howsoever arising in relation to the Event.
3. The participants (including their heirs, successors and assigns) agree to hold the Organisers, Sponsors, appointed officials/suppliers (each an **'Indemnified Party'**) harmless and keep each Indemnified Party fully and effectively indemnified from and against any and all losses, costs (including legal costs on a full indemnity basis), claims, damage and expenses whatsoever which any of them may incur (directly or indirectly) as a result of their breach of any of these Rules and Regulations.

General

4. This event is only open to registered participants of POSB PAssion Run for Kids 2018.
5. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, delay, postpone or change the venue, date and time of the Event for whatever reasons, including inclement weather or other unfavourable weather conditions (e.g. haze). In the event of an emergency arising from any incidents affecting the key installations in the vicinity of the Event venue, the Event may be cancelled without prior notice. There will be no fee refund if the Event is cancelled for whatever reason.
6. Participants consent to Esprimo’s collection and use of the participant’s personal data and the use and disclosure of the participant’s personal data by/to the Organisers and/or their agents or vendors and such other third party for the purpose of the Event. The participant agrees to the terms of the DBS Privacy Policy, a copy which can be found at www.dbs.com/privacy. The participants agree that the Organisers may contact them for any matter in relation to this Event, including but not limited to receiving notification e-mails and/or SMSes in connection with this Event.

If a third party registers on behalf of a participant for the Event (the “**Registering Party**”), the Registering Party confirms that he/she has obtained consent from the participant and consents on behalf of the participant to Esprimo’s and Organisers’ collection, use and disclosure of the participant’s personal data for the purpose of the Event.
